Kaufman Lynn Construction brought home top honors with three Eagle awards and one Pyramid award from the Florida East Coast Chapter of Associated Builders & Contractors (ABC), the leading commercial construction trade association in Florida. The awards were presented October 22 in Aventura, Florida.

The ABC Excellence in Construction Awards recognizes achievement in several criteria, including jobsite and project conditions, difficulty of installation, complexity, project coordination, exterior, mechanical, electrical, interior finishes, safety and quality of finished product.

Kaufman Lynn Construction was honored for the following projects:

Jupiter Police Headquarters: Eagle Award, Government and Municipality, \$15-25 Million

A new Police headquarters for the Town of Jupiter, Florida. The two-story facility houses police operations, detention area, crime lab, virtual training simulator room, locker rooms and physical training/exercise room, and the Town’s data center. The new building was designed to withstand a 192-mph wind event and serves as the Town’s Emergency Operations Center.

Mareas at Botanica: Eagle Award, Multifamily Housing, \$30-50 million

A new multifamily project of 408 rental units in 18 three-story walk-up buildings in Miami. Amenities include a resort-style pool with cabanas, clubhouse, dog park, playground and a fitness center; part of a 138-acre mixed-use development including on-site preserves and planted areas designed to connect preservation areas.

Waterline Miami River: Eagle Award, Multifamily Housing, \$50-100 Million

A luxury apartment complex along the Miami River near Downtown Miami. The eight-story residential building has 346 units and parking garage; amenities include fitness center, motion studio, pool, tech hub, flex offices, conference rooms and game room, plus new sea wall and a one-acre park with a children’s playground, dog park and recreational area.

The Rise Plantation: Pyramid Award, Multifamily Housing, \$30-50 million

A seven-story, 171-unit luxury apartment building that replaces a defunct regional mall in Plantation, Florida. With restaurants and stores on the first floor, it offers a state-of-the art fitness center, elevated

pool deck, plush landscaping/outdoor sitting areas that are dog friendly, cellphone access control and a Sky Lounge for larger gatherings by tenants.
